A Word from the Spiritual Director

Grace, peace, and mercy be multiplied to you in the name that is above every name Jesus Christ. Greetings family, I pray this little post finds you all blessed and highly favored of God! Having made that point clear (I hope), lets examine the rest of that Col 2:6 ..."so walk in him." A Word from the Spiritual Director (cont.)

This is so simple, you're really gonna need somebody to help you misunderstand it. Now notice v 7 of Col 2... "Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving." Again, how were we saved? How are we to walk or live in Him? Grace thru faith ... I love how Paul uses the word "rooted" here, he's implying something has



been planted. Built up, once faith is "rooted" in you, it should be being built up, not torn or beaten down. Not only built, but "stablished" (established), unmovable, unshakeable, steadfast in the faith! So now that we know we are to be living our lives the same way we received Christ, lets heed the warning Paul gives in v8 of Col 2.

"Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the traditions of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ." If you have ever heard me speak or exhort more than once, you've probably heard me say this.."Faith begins where the will of God is known"! No, I didn't come up with that on my own but I have adopted it some time ago and I believe it with all my heart. Why am I even bringing this up you ask? Because v 8 warns us to "Beware". Here is the point



I'm trying to make, "Let Gods Word be true, and every man a liar". I'm not trying to belittle or put down anyone's doctrine or "philosophy's" unless they do not agree with the Word of God! Whether it be out of ignorance, spiritual laziness, or even desperation, people have come up with their own diluted versions or interpretations of God's Word. In other words, we have accepted lies, many of which have even come from behind the pulpits throughout the churches. and we have watered down the Word of God to meet or match our own experiences rather than "walking or living" in Christ's grace through faith. Our prayer should be "God I want the experiences in my life to meet or match what your Word says". Or Lord I be-



lieve but help thou mine unbelief". Beware of anyone who tells you "God has cursed you to teach you something" "You stay sick all the time because God is teaching you a lesson". I could go on and on..."God doesn't care about your prosperity, and so your being broke all the time and not being able to pay your bills just means God just created you to be poor". None of the aforementioned is biblical! Beware!!! God gets a bad rap for a lot of things He's not responsible for.

Rom 10:17 "So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God!" Our faith is totally and completely dependant on "The Word of God" not



the word of men or men's philosophy. Your faith must be rooted in Christ, Whom the bible refers to as The Rock. Matt 7:24-27 "Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man. which builded his house upon a rock. And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock: And everyone that heareth these sayings of mine and doeth

them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand; And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it."-- As I pondered on the defeated and downcast children of God, I know the Lord pointed me to this passage of scripture. Notice this parable is speaking about two kinds of people, both

man should cast seed into the ground; And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come."-- Mark 4:14 "The Sower soweth the word"-- The Lord's will for our lives is to be overcomers, and to be a people of joy and peace. His Word is the seed that is planted inside of us, remember "faith cometh by hearing, hearing by the word"? Matt told us there were those who heard the word but they didn't do what they heard. These people were defeated by the storms of life. I believe these people rejected knowledge, or they were lacking knowledge, thus they were destroyed.

We cannot cheat God's law of seed, time and harvest. You may cram for an exam and pass a test because you stayed up late the night before the test and studied. Most will admit, though they

You cannot go out the night before the harvest and plant your seeds and expect to reap like those who planted, weeded, nourished, built up, (put time into) so that when harvest time was ready, they actually had something to harvest. Gods word is a much needed seed that you and I need to have rooted in us if we ever expect our faith to grow to the point that we will be able to harvest when the time comes!! The storms of life have beaten upon all of us... if we're not

"heard these sayings" and both experienced storms in their lives and yet one withstood the storms of life and the other did not. We see the exact same thing in our world today, there are the same two different kinds of people. All of us experience the storms and yet not all are able to withstand them. Hos 4:6 "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge." We are a destroyed people because of a lack and rejection of knowledge! It does not have to be this way! We can stand in faith on the Word of God and be victorious and be overcomers in this life if we will "walk or live" in God's grace thru faith! Thanks be unto God who always causes me to triumph! I know I'm saying a lot here but please be patient I'm almost done.. Mark 4:26-29 "And He said, 'So is the kingdom of God, as if a
